The meeting was called to order at 8:04 AM ET. The roll was called and introductions were made.

MOTION: Gi-Joon Nam moved to approve the April 2024 EC meeting minutes as written. Tsung-Yi Ho seconded. Motion passed.

MOTION: Gi-Joon Nam moved to approve the May 2024 EC meeting agenda with updates. Qi Zhu seconded. Motion passed.

ML EDA - Hu/Zhu

Jiang shared information regarding the SLICE: Shared Machine Learning Infrastructure for the Community of EDA initiative. The goal of the initiative is to build open-source infrastructure for the EDA community

Jiang noted that no financial support is needed from CEDA, however, an endorsement for the initiative would be appreciated.

Miguel noted that CEDA is already participating in several initiatives that share similar overall goals, most notably the participation in the IEEE AI Coalition and the support for the International Workshop on LLM-Aided Design (LAD '24) event, so connecting the key contacts for each is important in keeping related information flowing.

Aparna has agreed to be CEDA's presentative for the IEEE AI Coalition initiative and shared that the initial meeting will be held on 6 June in Boston, MA. Additionally, Aparna offered to share the SLICE initiative during that meeting.

MOTION: Qi Zhu moves to support the initiative on developing a shared machine learning infrastructure for the EDA community. Tsung-Yi Ho seconded. Motion passed.

Division I Meeting at ISCAS - Bolchini


The Division I meeting was held on 21 May 2024 at ISCAS in Singapore. Cristiana represented CEDA at this meeting and presented an educational proposal targeting prospective high school and early university students. Several CEDA EC members were in attendance, as well.

The meeting report and the final slides Cristiana presented will be shared with the EC at the BoG meeting.

The attending OUs discussed creating the Open-Silicon Chips Initiative which would be a joint effort between all of Division I to be presented to IEEE.







The project aims to encourage students to explore and enroll in EDA courses in early university. No CEDA financial support is needed currently, but eventually, the project will need CEDA's support in funding materials for the program and developing the shared educational materials. Politecnico di Torino and Politecnico di Milano have committed to purchasing the needed hardware for the program.

Cristiana asked CEDA to officially recognize Enrico Macii's involvement and leadership with the project and to categorize the project as a technical activity. In the ensuing discussion, the EC agreed with the importance of this ongoing effort by Enrico and Cristiana. Miguel announced that Enrico Macii would lead these engagement / educational activities and will invite Enrico to present alongside Cristiana at the EC and BoG meetings at DAC in June.
